I. ROUTINE BUSINESS

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska, met in regular session in Council Chambers, 809 Main Street, Bridgeport, Nebraska, on the 31st day of August, 2009, beginning at 5:00 p.m.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, Mayor J.W. Berg called the meeting to order. Roll call resulted as follows: Present: Gary Oltmann, Willis Beyer, Greg Lussetto, and Jason Schmunk; Absent: None.

Staff members present were: City Administrator Bill Boyer.

The Mayor presided and the City Administrator recorded the proceedings.

Mayor Berg announced, "In accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, the open meetings act is posted at the back of the Council Chambers for the review of the public."

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in three public places, City Hall, the U.S. Post Office, and Prairie Winds Community Center, a designated method of notice given, as shown by proof of posting.

Notice was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

The Mayor asked if there were any letters of public correspondence for the board. There were none.

The Mayor asked if there was any member of the public who wished to comment on an item that was not on the agenda. There were none.

II. REGULAR AGENDA

4. Don Dye with M.C. Schaff and Associates presented the following bids to the City Council for Street Improvement District 2009-1:

- a) Simon Contractors, Scottsbluff: \$235,400.00
- b) Paul Reed Construction, Gering: \$281,864.39

Dye said that both bids were considerably under the engineer's estimate of \$378,150.00, and both bidders indicated they would start paving next spring.

Councilman Oltmann moved to award the bid to Simon Contractors for \$235,400.00, seconded by Councilman Lussetto. Roll call resulted as follows: Aye: Schmunk, Oltmann, Beyer, Lussetto; Nay: None. Motion carried.

There being no other business, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 5:03 p.m.
