I. ROUTINE BUSINESS

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska, met in regular session in Council Chambers, 809 Main Street, Bridgeport, Nebraska, on the 29th day of September, 2009, beginning at 6:04 p.m.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, Council President Jason Schmunk called the meeting to order. Roll call resulted as follows: Present: Gary Oltmann, Willis Beyer, Greg Lussetto, and Jason Schmunk; Absent: Mayor J.W. Berg.

Staff members present were: City Clerk/Treasurer Doretta Huck, City Administrator Bill Boyer, Public Works Director Wayne Kautz, Street Superintendent Dave Smith, Utilities Assistants Dan Smith, Perry Nelson, and Rich Stichka, Deputy City Clerk Brittani Jimenez, Community Center Operations Director Kellye Riggs, Community Center Building Supervisor Deb Schneider, Police Chief Milo Cardenas, and Police Officer Daniel Flores.

The Mayor presided and the City Clerk recorded the proceedings.

Council President Schmunk announced, "In accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, the open meetings act is posted at the back of the Council Chambers for the review of the public."

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in three public places, City Hall, the U.S. Post Office, and Prairie Winds Community Center, a designated method of notice given, as shown by proof of posting.

Notice was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.
